



# New Student AS PHOTOGRAPHY ASSIGNMENT

## Information

---

If you are not currently studying towards a GCSE in Art and/or Graphics, a photo assignment must be completed. The intention being that you demonstrate your level of interest and commitment to this very popular course.

---

### Three Choices of Assignment

1. Produce a sequence of 10-12 photographs based upon the theme: A Familiar Journey Photographed in an Unfamiliar Way.
2. Produce a sequence of 10-12 photographs based upon the theme: Home.
3. Produce 10-12 photographs based upon the theme: My Essex.

### How is it Assessed

The work will be assessed in much the same way that imagery produced for the AS course is. Therefore, you may wish to consider camera-angle, point-of-view, contrast, framing, camera-technique, composition etc. Essentially, as with all briefs at AS-level, your response to the assignment should be seen as an opportunity to look at your environment imaginatively and to use your camera creatively.

### Camera Specification

In order to exercise control of the photographic-image, students on the AS Art & Design: Photography course at SEEVIC College are recommended to use single-lens reflex digital cameras. Information concerning camera requirements is available from the College.
