

# WHAT LEVEL IS RIGHT FOR ME?

LEVEL	QUALIFICATION	GENERAL ENTRY REQUIREMENTS
<b>LEVEL 3</b>	AAT INTERMEDIATE LEVEL	AAT Foundation or four GCSEs at grade B or above including GCSE English Language and Maths.
	A LEVELS* (A BTEC National Award may be taken in place of one A Level)	Students will need the following: 1. An average GCSE points score of 4.7 calculated from your eight best GCSEs or equivalent vocational qualifications but <b>MUST</b> include GCSE Maths and English Language (see page 84 for details of the calculation). 2. At least five GCSEs at grade C or above which must include GCSE English Language.
	ADMINISTRATION & SECRETARIAL STUDIES	At least four GCSEs at grade C or above, which should include English Language or a related vocational qualification at Merit Level plus GCSE English Language at grade C or above. If choosing an AS Level in addition to one of the courses, students must meet the A Level general entry requirements (as above).

	ADVANCED DIPLOMA*	Students will need the following: 1. An average GCSE points score of 4.7 calculated from your eight best GCSEs or equivalent vocational qualifications but <b>MUST</b> include GCSE Maths and English Language (see page 84 for details of the calculation). 2. At least five GCSEs at grade C or above which must include GCSE English Language.
	BTEC NATIONAL AWARD*	These qualifications will normally be taken as part of an A Level programme. Students may only take one BTEC National Award in place of one A Level.
	BTEC NATIONAL CERTIFICATE/DIPLOMA*	At least four GCSEs at grade C or above or a BTEC First Diploma (or equivalent) in a related area at Merit level.
<b>LEVEL 2</b>	AAT FOUNDATION LEVEL	At least four GCSEs at grade D or above including GCSE English Language and Maths.

	BTEC FIRST DIPLOMA*	At least two GCSEs at grade D or above or a BTEC Introductory Diploma (or equivalent) in a related area at Merit level.
	GCSES* (Including Vocational Paralegal Studies)	It is expected that students pursuing a programme of GCSE courses will have already achieved a grade C in at least three GCSE subjects and an average GCSE points score of 3.5 (see page 84 for details of the calculation).
