SEEVIC College have created a football coaching programme that offers highly talented football players the opportunity to continue with post 16 full time education while receiving coaching from professional FA qualified football coaches.

The scheme is a 3 year programme offering a choice of two sports science academic courses. Details of courses can be found in the SEEVIC College prospectus.

FOOTBALL

Players accepted onto the scheme will train with a highly talented squad and strive to reach the highest level possible in either professional or amateur football. Each player will train on a daily basis and the sessions can vary depending on curriculum time but will not be less than 7 hours per week. Sessions can vary in type but are usually on the sports field where players will work on various technical and tactical situations.

Players will have a specific training programme designed to ensure their fitness levels are improved and maintained.

Players will benefit from various video analysis sessions to improve their tactical knowledge of the game. Each player will take the FA level 1 in coaching and some may be selected to take level 2.

The programme offers three levels for players to compete in from County to National level.

WHO IS ACCEPTED INTO THE SCHEME

Players must enrol for an academic course at SEEVIC College to apply but spaces on the football programme are based on playing ability. Players are required to take part in a series of trials to prove their ability. Fill in and return the application form and the coaching staff will invite you to the next trial date.

SCORE COACHING STAFF

Dave Thompson (Football Programme Manager)
Laurie Carter (Football Programme Manager)

Both coaches have vast experience in professional and non league football.

Dave Thompson spent 7 years working at Southend United where he progressed from coach to Centre of Excellence Manager. He then moved to Charlton Athletic as Centre Director before being recruited to coach for Chelsea FC.

Laurie Carter worked at Southend United for 8 years coaching various age groups from under 13's to the Youth team. Laurie also held the position of Centre of Excellence Manager and is currently a Coach Educator for the Football Association.

Both coaches are committed to the development of the players and are currently taking their full 'A' Licence with the FA and also hold various other qualifications.

GIRLS SCORE PROGRAMME

SEEVIC College also run a girls football programme where the training scheme runs similar to the boys. Competition is at National and County level in both leagues and cup competition.

Lucy Faraday is the SCORE coach for girls. Lucy is an ex-SEEVIC student who after university spent some time coaching in the USA. Currently taking the UEFA 'B' Licence, she also holds various other qualifications and not only coaches but plays at a good level. Apart from her commitment to the SCORE scheme Lucy also works as a community coach for Essex County FA.

TOURS

Players on the scheme enjoy the opportunity to travel away with the squads to training camps held annually abroad. Both the boys and girls SCORE squads, attended camps in Holland, Malta or Italy where apart from the training have played against good quality foreign opposition.

ACADEMIC COURSES

All SCORE students will study courses over 3 years, those who achieve less than 4C's at GCSE will study a BTEC 1st Diploma in Sport followed by a 2 year BTEC National Diploma in either Sports Development or Sport & Exercise Science. Those who achieve 4C's or above including English & Maths or Science will study a full National Diploma in either Sports

Development or Sport & Exercise Science. Students having completed the above courses should be able to access university/higher education courses.

WHERE DO I GO AFTER THE PROGRAMME?

On completion of the 3 year programme students will be able to enter employment in the sport and recreation industry. They may choose to progress to higher education and study sport coaching/sport science-related courses leading to careers in teaching, sports coaching, the leisure industry, fitness advice, the Armed Forces, the police and sports therapy. Students can also progress directly on to the degree offered at SEEVIC College in Coaching Science.
